Jean Rogerson Scholarship

The Jean Rogerson Scholarships are awarded each year to senior students who are committed to Tommy More Outreach, academic excellence, the College Chapel and the Student Club.

Applicants must be returning residents of the College.

Two (2) Scholarships are offered to the value \$2000 each.

Applications close at 4.00pm on the Friday prior to the commencement of Semester 1 each year.

The Application Process

1. The application form for the Jean Rogerson Scholarship is available on the College web site www.stmc.uwa.edu.au or through the office.
2. Applicants must be returning residents of the College.
3. Applicants must have passed all units in the previous semester. Please provide your academic statement with this application.
4. Applications for scholarships should be directed to the attention of the Head of College.
5. In considering applications for scholarships, the selection committee – comprising the Head of College, the Deputy Head of College and at least one other member of the College Council – will take into account each applicant's:
 - a. financial position
 - b. commitment to and level of academic achievement
 - c. contribution to the life of the College including the Chapel, Tommy More Outreach and Student Club activities.
6. Reference to the criteria in point 5 above is essential in completing this application.
7. If the successful applicant does not persevere with tertiary studies to the end of the year, or fails two or more exams in the first semester assessments, payment of scholarship funds will be discontinued.
8. Payment takes the form of a credit in fees.
